Sunday mornings to celebrate and learn about God



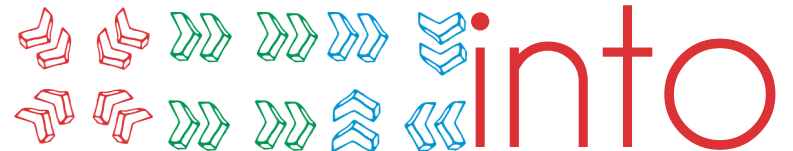

Deuteronomy 34:10-12

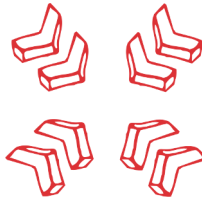
For Individuals and Life Groups

March 1, 2015

Introduction:

In this series we will be looking at five Old Testament passages where God reveals himself in a unique way to his chosen people. These “face to face” encounters have four elements: divine initiation, profound intimacy, intentional solitude and supernatural verification. Not only will we explore the encounters in their original contexts, we will also discover what it might mean to have a face to face encounter with God today.

Now, at the end of his life Moses is shown the promise that God gave to the Israelites. For context on this passage read Genesis 12:1-8, Genesis 15:12-20 (The promise) and Numbers 20:6-13 (The reason Moses wouldn't enter the land).



Into the scriptures

Read: Deuteronomy 34:1-12

What do you notice about the passage itself? (Structure, repeated words or ideas, unique words, main points...)

From this passage describe God's relationship with Moses.

What is that significance of God laying hands on Joshua?

Knowing all you now know about Moses, read Heb. 3:1-6. Describe Moses as a picture of Christ.



Into my life

Deuteronomy 30:15-20 and John 15:9-17 share some similarities in what they are trying to say. Out of Moses' relationship with God and Jesus' relationship with his Father came some challenges to us. Read the passages and share what God is calling you to live out? What will you do about it?

What gets in the way of you “choosing life?”

Like Moses commissioned Joshua he also commissions us through the Holy Spirit. Pray for each other regarding the call he has for each of you.
