


Isaiah 6:1 -8

## ***Introduction:***

Throughout the Bible there are encouraging, intriguing, and challenging questions that are asked. In this wide-ranging teaching series we will explore seven questions that still make an impact today.

Around 647 BCE the nation of Israel had recently gone through a split in what were known as the North and South kingdoms. Uzziah, the second king of the northern kingdom, has just passed away. While he was young he followed the Lord but eventually his pride at the power of his nation distracted him from what was important. This pride was a reflection of the whole nation attempting to live independent of God. They needed to be reminded of who they belonged to and what they were there for.



## Into the scriptures


Read: Isaiah 6:1-8

What do you notice about the passage itself? (Structure, repeated words or ideas, unique words, main points...)

Describe the image of God that Isaiah sees. What are his qualities and attributes? How does that compare to the human king Uzziah? (See 2 Chronicles 26 for a description of his rule)

Describe Isaiah's portrayal of himself and God's response. (See Is 29:13, Matthew 9:2, Hebrews 9:13-14, Is 43:25)

What is the promise to claim hold of in this passage?

How will you be different this week because of what you have just read?


