


Mark 10:46-52

**Introduction:**

Throughout the Bible there are encouraging, intriguing, and challenging questions that are asked. In this wide-ranging teaching series we will explore seven questions that still make an impact today.

After 3 years of ministry, Jesus is on his last trip to Jerusalem before his arrest and crucifixion. Along the way he meets a blind man whose only hope was this man walking past...



## Into the scriptures

Read: Mark 10:35-52


What do you notice about the passage itself? (Structure, repeated words or ideas, unique words, main points...)

Two times in this chapter Jesus says, “What do you want me to do for you?” Compare the two stories. How are they different? How are they similar?

What is at the heart of the request of James and John (v.42-43). What does Jesus challenge them to do?

What is at the heart of the blind man’s request? What is his response?

What is the significance of the blind man saying, “Jesus, Son of David?” (See Jeremiah 23:5, 6; Romans 1:3, 4; Luke 4:18, 19)



## Into my life

Has there ever been a time in your life where you were desperate for God to intervene? What was the situation? What was your experience of God during that time?

In our culture, what does it mean and look like to be desperate for Jesus? (In our work, in our schools, in our clubs, in our neighborhoods)

What is the promise to claim hold of in this passage?

How will you be different this week because of what you have just read?



## Into the world

The crowd was trying to keep the blind man from meeting Jesus. How do our actions keep those in need from reaching Jesus? What can we do about it?


