


Luke 2:1-21 & Matthew 2:1-12

Introduction:

There are two accounts of the birth of Jesus found in Matthew and Luke. In our passage for this study Luke records the personal words that God gave to three important people regarding promises he had made. When one lady met the mother of Jesus she said, “Blessed is she who has believed that the Lord would fulfill his promises to her!” (Luke 2:45). Jesus is the one who saves! Into the scriptures




Read: Luke 2:1-21 & Matthew 2:1-12




