Day 21

The Attributes of God

As for God, His way is perfect; the word of the Lord is proven. He is a shield for all who take refuge in Him. For who is God besides the Lord? And who is the Rock except our God? (2 Samuel 22:31-32)

The Lord longs to be gracious and rises to show compassion. For the Lord is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for Him! (Isaiah 30:18)

The Works of God

The heavens declare the glory of God, and the skies proclaim the work of His hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. (Psalms 19:1-2)

The Lord is the great God, the great King above all gods. In His hand are the depths of the earth, and the summits of the mountains are His also. The sea is His, for He made it, and His hands formed the dry land. He is our God and we are the people of His pasture and the sheep under His care. (Psalms 95:3-5, 7)

The Attributes of God

My Relationship to God

And this is the will of Him who sent You, that You will lose none of all that He has given You, but raise them up at the last day. Day 23

The Attributes of God

Will God indeed dwell on earth? Heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain You. (1 Kings 8:27)

My Relationship to God

God is my refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore I will not fear, though the earth changes and the mountains slip into the heart of the sea. (Psalms 46:1-2)

Discretion will protect me, and understanding will guard me. (Proverbs 2:6-11)

My Relationship to Others

When I give, it will be given to me; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be poured into my lap. For with the measure I use, it will be measured back to me. (Luke 6:38)

He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one should give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion; for God loves a cheerful giver. The Attributes of God

The Works of God

My Relationship to Others
