Day 37

### The Works of God

Christ has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of Himself. And as it is appointed for man to die once and after that to face judgment, so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many; and He will appear a second time, not to bear sin but to bring salvation to those who eagerly wait for Him. ([Hebrews 9:26-28](#))

I have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God, to myriads of angels, and to the assembly and church of the firstborn, who are enrolled in heaven. Day 39

### The Attributes of God

Let me fall into the hands of the Lord, for His mercies are very great; but do not let me fall into the hands of men. ([1 Chronicles 21:13](#))

You, Lord, are good and ready to forgive and abundant in mercy to all who call upon You. ([Psalm 86:5](#))

### The Works of God

We should not be ignorant about those who fall asleep or grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus. According to the Lord's own word, we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. ([1 Thessalonians 4:13-17](#))

We are looking for the blessed hope and the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, who gave Himself for us to redeem us from all iniquity and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good works. ([Titus 2:13-14](#))

### My Relationship to God

### The Character I Want to Cultivate

I want to be above reproach, temperate, sensible, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money, one who manages his own family well, and who keeps his children under control with proper respect. And I want a good reputation with outsiders, so that I will not fall into disgrace and the snare of the devil. ([1 Timothy 3:2-4, 7](#))

I want to be above reproach, blameless as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not fond of dishonest gain, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sensible, just, holy, and self-controlled. ([Titus 1:6-8](#))

### My Relationship to Others

The husband should fulfill his marital duty to his wife, and likewise the wife to her husband. The wife's body does not belong to her alone, but also to her husband. In the same way, the husband's body does not belong to him alone, but also to his wife. ([1 Corinthians 7:3-4](#))

Each husband must love his own wife as he loves himself, and each wife must respect her husband. ([Ephesians 5:33](#))

Day 40

### The Attributes of God

You have chosen me as Your witness and servant so that I may know and believe You and understand that You are the Lord. Before You no God was formed, nor will there be one after You. ([Isaiah 43:10](#))

The Lord God is the Alpha and the Omega, who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty. ([Revelation 1:8](#))

### The Works of God

Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel, because He has visited us and has redeemed His people. He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of His servant David (as He spoke by the mouth of His holy prophets of long ago), salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us—to show mercy to our fathers and to remember His holy covenant, the oath He swore to our father Abraham, to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve Him without fear in holiness and righteousness before Him all our days. ([Luke 1:68–75](#))

The Scriptures predicted that the Christ should suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. ([Luke 24:46–47](#))

### My Relationship to God

God will keep me strong to the end, so that I will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is faithful, through whom I was called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. ([1 Corinthians 1:8–9](#))

Thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of Him. ([2 Corinthians 2:14](#))

### The Character I Want to Cultivate

I will rejoice in hope, persevere in affliction, and continue steadfastly in prayer. ([Romans 12:12](#))

I will fight the good fight of faith and lay hold of the eternal life to which I was called when I made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. In the sight of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontius Pilate, I want to keep this command without blemish or reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which God will bring about in His own time. ([1 Timothy 6:12–15a](#))

### My Relationship to Others

Children should obey their parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise—“that it may go well with you, and that you may live long on the earth.” ([Ephesians 6:1–3](#))

Day 41

### The Attributes of God

Lord, You have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. Before the mountains were born or You brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting, You are God. You turn men back into dust, and say, "Return, O children of men." For a thousand years in Your sight are like yesterday when it passes by or like a watch in the night. ([Psalm 90:1-4](#))

My days are like a lengthened shadow, and I wither away like grass. But You, O Lord, will endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations. Of old, You laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You will endure; they will all wear out like a garment. Like clothing, You will change them, and they will be discarded. But You are the same, and Your years will have no end. ([Psalm 102:11-12, 25-27](#))

### The Works of God

Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a Man. For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ, the firstfruits; afterward, those who are Christ's at His coming. Then the end will come, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He has abolished all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. ([1 Corinthians 15:20-26](#))

We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. For this perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and this mortal with immortality. ([1 Corinthians 15:51-53](#))

### My Relationship to God

As many as received Christ, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name, who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. ([John 1:12-13](#))

Unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God; unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. The wind blows wherever it pleases, and we hear its sound, but we cannot tell where it comes from, or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit. ([John 3:3, 5-6, 8](#))
